

# Engelstad Park

- First Park in the City of Thief River Falls.
- May 15, 1899, city purchased parcel of land from J.F. Burns for \$540.00 for dedicated park land.
- 1987 – Park dedicated as the “Ole E. Engelstad Park”.
- Formerly known as “Eastside Park.”



- 1993 – Received a DNR Grant for development of (4) tennis courts and a basketball court.
- 1997 – Constructed a new warming house/restroom facility.
